TREETOPS MONTESSORI OUR PHILOSOPHY

Treetops Montessori has been providing first-class education since 1993. We believe that future happiness and success depends on a sound beginning. Under the supervision of highly experienced and qualified Montessori trained staff, your child will receive the individual attention necessary for the achievement of their highest potential.

Stepping into our mixed aged classroom, you will be impressed by the level of focus and engagement of the children working with their own selected learning materials. The individual lessons and daily activities are targeted to each child's interests and abilities making the learning perfectly tailored to each student.

In addition to the Montessori teachings, Treetops children enjoy a French lesson every day, weekly yoga with mindfulness practice, music class with Ryan from "Through the Art of Music", art, crafts, dance and outdoor activities.

Throughout the year, educational field trips are offered to provide children with local cultural experiences.

Mindfulness: At Treetops, we incorporate mindfulness into our weekly yoga practice. The purpose of teaching mindfulness to the children is to give them skills to develop their awareness, to understand how emotions make them feel and to provide tools for self-control.



What is Montessori Work?

Sensorial: Includes activities that allow the child to refine each of their senses: Sight, Touch, Smell, Taste and Sound.

Language: Based on phonetic awareness, children work through specific hands-on and tactile language materials.

Math: With the use of concrete learning materials, each exercise builds upon another and the child gradually moves to addition, subtraction, multiplication, and fractions.

Practical Life: Materials and works are inspired by 'real-life' tasks, and teach children important skills through fun, step by step activities that convey respect, responsibility and caring.

Culture: allows the child to explore the natural world around them and includes: Geography, Zoology, Botany, History and Science.

THE MONTESSORI METHOD

Dr. Maria Montessori founded a philosophy that later inspired sweeping reforms in modern education. She believed that children have a desire to explore, discover and learn about their environment.

Montessori schools aim to help children build the foundations for a lifetime of creative learning. They are based on Dr. Montessori's observations that each child is unique and should be helped to develop to his or her fullest potential.

The early years are critical, and children should have every opportunity to strengthen positive attitudes towards learning during these formative years.

Montessori children learn how to learn. They establish patterns of concentration and perseverance which help them become competent learners for life. They are helped to do this in the "prepared environment" of a Montessori classroom. These rooms contain scientifically researched and developed, sequenced and interrelated materials which allow the children to explore through manipulation and discovery.

Although the curriculum is structured, each child moves through it at their own pace. It is the teacher's role, on the basis of study and observation of the child, to prepare the environment which will stimulate, challenge and satisfy each child.

In a Montessori classroom, there is a special atmosphere of cheerful orderliness, calmness and purposeful work. The Montessori approach is child-centered but adult guided. It is structured but free for learning, emphasizing basics in an enjoyable manner.

The Montessori Method aims to develop each child's; concentration, co-ordination, persistence in completing a task, self-discipline, orderliness, desire to learn, initiative, creative self-expression and independence.

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FEE POLICY AND TERMS OF ENROLLMENT

The tuition may be paid in one of the following manners.

- 1. One lump sum payment on or before Aug 1st of the intended school year (a 5% discount will be applied)
- 2. The enrollment fee and tuition deposit due upon registration followed by a monthly installment plan beginning the first month of the intended school year

The enrollment fee and deposit are non-refundable if the child is registered but does not attend the school

In order to withdraw a child from our program, parents must provide a written and signed notice of withdrawal two full calendar months in advance. If this notice is not provided, two full calendar months tuition payment must be provided

Withdrawal after April 1st will not be refunded

Deductions are not allowed for voluntary or involuntary absences (school holidays, sickness, family holidays, etc.)

Special Circumstances: In the event of a situation beyond our control (fire, flood, earthquake, pandemic etc.) where the school must be closed for a period longer than one month, your tuition that was prepaid or due for the following month, will be refunded to you or not collected if the school does not reopen. Tuition paid for the initial month when the event occurs along with the last month deposit will not be refunded.

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
